She is a half-sister to the Stakes Winners LONG ISLAND TEA 4,1:53.4 (\$112K) and MOONSHINE BALLS 3,1:56.3, both out of the Stakes Winner STRONG TEA 2,1:58.4 (\$241K), a half-sister to the 3YOTF of the Year OOLONG 3,1:54.4 (\$744K). She sells in-foal to Hambletonian Winner TRIXTON 3,1:50.3 (\$947K), sire of 7 in 1:56 from his first crop, including MOTHER BONNIE 2,1:55-'18, TAYLOR SWIFTLY 2,1:55.1-'18 and STARITA 2,1:55.2-'18. DONATO HANOVER mares have produced the likes of World Champion PLUNGE BLUE CHIP 3,1:49.4-'18 (\$777K) and LILY STRIDE 2,1:55.2 (\$392K).
