A former \$87,000 yearling purchase, he is the first foal from the Stakes Winner LADY RIVIERA 2,1:58 (\$162K), a half-sister to World Champion, Horse of the Year and leading sire CHAPTER SEVEN 4,1:50.1 (\$1.9M). He fits NW-2 races and is a chancy prospect for the 2019 season, and with his looks and pedigree he should only move forward with time and maturity. Check for updates.
