Last year at 2, he was a KYSS winner (1:55.2) and finished second in the \$250,000 final (to Venerate), timed in 1:52.2. He was also third in the International Stallion S. (to Southwind Tyrion) in his 1:51.1 world record mile. This year at 3, he reduced his record to 1:54.2f at Harrah's Philadelphia, and was third in a NJSS at The Meadows (to Hambletonian finalists Locatelli and Sonofamistry). A 4-time career winner, he has been 1-2-3 in 14 of 20 career starts. A brother to the 1:51 sire BAR HOPPING, he has trotted with the best of the division at 2 and 3. A former \$65,000 yearling, he would a great addition to any racing stable wherever you compete, north or south of the border, and a possible stallion prospect down the road being by the great MUSCLE HILL and a brother to a rising young sire. Racing at time of entry and to the sale, he finished second (on Sept 9) in his last start at time of entry-check for important updates.
