STATEMENT: One of the best young pacing colts in the sale, this 3-year-old colt by STAY HUNGRY is a winner of over \$304,000 in 2023. He paced to his p,3,1:48.2-'23 record at The Meadowlands winning the Tompkins S., and was second in the \$668,000 Meadowlands Pace to likely Horse of the Year CONFEDERATE, timed in 1:47.3-'26.1. He was also second in a heat of the Little Brown Jug (timed in 1:50.4h); the North America Cup consolation, and fourth in the Cane Pace. In his last start at time of consignment (Oct. 8), he was an excellent third in the \$236,000 Tattersalls S. (to CONFEDERATE). In 14 starts this year, he has been 1-2-3 in 10 of them, and never missed a check! In fact, in his last 9-mile track starts, he has paced in sub-1:50 fashion in every one! A classy racehorse, he has hit the board in 12 of 17 career starts, shows individual miles in 1:47.3, 1:48.2, 1:48.3, 1:48.3, etc., and paced a last quarter in :25.3. Lightly raced, he checks all the boxes, and there is no reason to think he can't graduate to the next level in 2024. On the breeding side, he is by the successful young sire STAY HUNGRY p,3,1:47.3 (\$1.3M), sire of 88 in 1:55, including World Champion SEVEN COLORS (\$705K), ZANATTA (\$550K), ANNAPOLIS HANOVER (\$323K), etc., and a 3/4-brother to TENTHOUSAND ANGELS p,1:52.2 (\$209K) and half-brother to PRETTY ANGEL EYES p,4,1:53.3f (\$162K). Without question, he is one of the best racing prospects in the sale and he remains eligible to this year's Progress Pace. Check for updates.
