An outstanding individual with an exquisite pedigree, he has tremendous potential both on and off the track. As a racehorse he's shown it all, success on all size tracks, opening and closing quarters in 26 flat, and tenacity. Unfortunately, he's drawn poorly in major events or his earnings would be much higher. His bloodlines suggest he will improve with age, as BETTOR SWEET won multiple Breeders Crowns as an aged horse, and SWEET LOU dazzled the sport as a 5 year-old. Has obvious appeal as a stallion, both here and abroad, as he is a half-brother to siring sensation SWEET LOU, is one of the fastest 2 year-old sons of international supersire BETTORS DELIGHT, and is a close relation of champion filly YOUAREMYCANDYGIRL. Finally, think of this: if he improves even a little bit (as his pedigree indicates he will) he has the potential to generate millions of dollars!
