A former \$60,000 yearling, she sells in foal to WHAT THE HILL 3,1:51.4 (\$1.2M), whose oldest foals are now 3-year-olds, including THE MIGHTY HILL (\$306K), BE MY BABY NOW (\$199K), SWINGING SENORITA (\$166K), CHULO (\$160K), etc. Last bred 2/28/22, the \$7,000 stud fee is paid and non-refundable. The resulting foal will be eligible for nomination to both the OHSS and KYSS programs as she has completed her 2022 KY residency requirements.
