Her first foal is the Stakes Winner MAKE A WISH DEO 2,1:58.4-'22, and she is a half-sister to the Stakes Winners BILLY FLYNN 3,Q1:52.4 (\$419K) and MR CHICAGO 3,1:53.3 (\$80K). A former \$50,000 yearling, she sells in foal to the World Champion, Yonkers Trot winner and 3YOTC of the Year SIX PACK 3,1:49.1 (\$1.9M), whose oldest crop are yearlings in 2022. Last bred 5/4/22, the \$10,000 stud fee is paid and non-refundable. The resulting foal will be eligible for nomination to the rich NJ\$\$ program. From only 2 starters, WISHING STONE mares have produced XIOMARA 3,1:58.1f-'22 and MAKE A WISH DEO 2,1:58.4-'22. From the family of Breeders' Crown Winner ESQUIRE SPUR 3,1:56f (\$336K), her second foal, a colt by Father Patrick, sold in Lexington for \$92,000, and she has a SIX PACK weaning filly on the ground.
