**STATEMENT:** One of the best race-mares to ever sell at public auction, this daughter of SHADOW PLAY took a record of p,1:48.1 enroute to career earnings of over \$2M. A 36-time career winner, she was a 3-time O'Brien Award winner at ages 3, 4 and 5; and a Dan Patch winner at age 5. She was a 1:50 or faster winner 11 times in her career (including 5 in sub-1:49), including 4-years in a row. Among her long list of accomplishments were wins in such events at the Roses Are Red S. (three times: 1:48.1, 1:48.3 and 1:48.4), Breeders' Crown (1:49.4), TVG Final (1:50), Milton S. (1:50), Chip Noble Memorial (1:50.3f), Golden Girls S., Lady Liberty S., etc. On the pedigree side, she is a half-sister to 3 \$100K winners, including LADY MEGHAN O p,1:50.4 (\$424K) and DRINKA BEER p,1:52.1f (\$232K), and out of LADY CAMELLA p,4,1:51.4 (\$203K). In addition to being the sire of the fastest horse ever BULLDOG HANOVER p,4,1:45.4-'22 (\$1.9M), SHADOW PLAY mares have produced 33 in 1:55, 14 \$100K winners, and the winners of over \$3M, including NEVERFORGETWHOUR (\$406K), SUNSHINEATTHEBEACH (\$209K), FADE OUT (\$180K), HEAVENISSOFARAWAY (\$180K), PEARL SNAPS (\$128K), etc. When she retired, only TWO mares had more 1:50 career miles: ANNDROVETTE and DROP THE BALL. This is a rare opportunity to purchase one of the best mares in recent memory. Her oldest foal is a yearling by BIG BAD JOHN, and she sells open and ready to breed to the stallion of your choice.
