By the sire of the winners of over \$13M in 2022, he is a brother to the Stakes Winner U S CAPTAIN p,3,1:49 (\$350K), and out of the 3YOPF of the Year AMERICAN JEWEL p,3,1:48.2 (\$1.8M), herself a 3/4-sister to Breeders' Crown Winner LUCK BE WITHYOU p,1:47.4f (\$1.4M). A former \$350,000 yearling purchase, he has paced in sub-1:55 fashion in every one of his pari-mutuel starts, including his last start at time of consignment (Sept. 20), where he drew the unlucky post 10 in the final of the Kentucky Golden Rod Series. A colt with a world of speed, he has a nice foundation under him, and with his stunning looks, is a promising young pacer with one of the best pedigrees around. If he can live up to his lofty lineage, he could be the bargain of the sale. He remains eligible to NW/1 races, and a terrific candidate to climb the conditioned ladder in Pennsylvania and elsewhere for his new connections in 2023. Check for important updates.
