A former \$250,000 yearling paced to his p,2,1:51.3-'22 record winning a leg of the Kentucky Golden Rod Series, pacing his last 1/4 of :27, and shows other individual miles in 1:52, 1:52.1, 1:52.3, 1:52.4, etc. In fact, he has paced in 1:55 or faster in every one of his 7 pari-mutuel starts, and sub-1:53 in 5 of them. By the sire of the winners of over \$13M in 2022, he is a 3/4-brother to the top Stakes Winner PEBBLE BEACH p,2,1:48.4 (\$1M), and just the second foal from a sister to VINTAGE MASTER p,4,1:48.1f (\$2M), and from the classic NAPA VALLEY family of horses like SILK STOCKINGS. A colt with a world of speed, he shows last quarters as fast as :26.3. He has a nice foundation under him, and with his stunning looks, is a talented young pacer with one of the best pedigrees around. He remains eligible to NW/2 races and is a terrific candidate to climb the conditioned ladder in Pennsylvania and elsewhere for his new connections in 2023. Check for important updates.
