In his 2 pari-mutuel starts to date, he was timed in 1:56.2f (finishing second) and 1:55.3f, finishing fourth in a leg of the Stallion Series at Harrah's Philadelphia. By the sire of PERFECT STING, SOUTHWIND GENDRY, MAD MAX HANOVER, etc., he is a half-brother to the Stakes Winners HAMMERING HANK p,2,1:51.1 (\$301K at 2 and 3) and HIS BEATS HANOVER p,3,1:50.4 (\$199K), and out of a half-sister to the Stakes and Open Winner DOCTOR BUTCH p,1:48.1 (\$1.6M). A former \$100,000 yearling purchase, this Pennsylvania-bred has already shown sub-1:56f speed, and like his sire (who made most of his SS as an older performer), is an ideal candidate to move forward with time and maturity as he approaches his 3-year-old season.
