STATEMENT: This Stakes Winning 3-year-filly by BETTING LINE is a winner of over \$51,000 in 2022, pushing her lifetime earnings to over \$158,000. A 3-time winner in '22, she took her p,3,1:51.4f-'22 record 2 starts back, winning the Keystone Classic at The Meadows. Earlier in the year she won a leg of the Stallion Series at The Meadows (1:53.2f). She was also second in the final of the Stallion Series (by a neck) at Pocono Downs, timed in 1:51.2f. For the year, she has hit the board in 6 of 9 starts, and picked up checks in all but one of them. As a 2YO, she was a 3-time stakes winner, earning over \$107,000 while taking a record of p,2,1:52.2, and was third in the final of Kindergarten Series (to Niki Hill and Treacherous Dragon). By Little Brown Jug Winner BETTING LINE p,3,1:47.2f (\$1.8M), she is a half-sister to WESTERN VACATION p,4,1:52.2h (\$110K), and out of the good mare ROBIN CRUISER p,4,1:51 (\$498K). Ultra-consistent, she sports a career summary of 22-7-3-6, has hit the board in over 70% of her starts, and only missed two purse checks in her career. A small track specialist, she is an excellent candidate for east-coast racing in 2023, especially for the fat purses at Yonkers, where in her only appearance, she paced in 1:53h.
