For the year, she has an impressive slate of 18-9-3-2, and only missed one purse check all year. Over the last 2 years, she has hit the board in 20 of 30 career starts. Needless to say, she is one of the best racing, and future broodmare, prospects. By the King of Trotting, she is from the family of Hambletonian Winner MARION MARAUDER 1:50.2 (\$3.3M).
