A 3-time winner in '22, she trotted to her 3,1:54f-'22 lifetime best winning a PASS at The Meadows, and was stakes placed in several other Pa.-bred events. In her last start at time of consignment (Sept. 24), she trotted in a career fastest 1:53.2 (with a last 1/4 of :27.1) in the Elegantimage S., and has trotted in 1:56 or faster in all but one of her seasonal starts. Last year as a 2YO, she took a 2,1:56 record winning a leg of the Pure Ivory Series; was second in the Champlain S. (to Adare Castle); and was third in a Peaceful Way elim. (to Venerable). By CANTAB HALL, she is out of a half-sister to World Champion and Horse of the Year CHAPTER SEVEN 4,1:50.1 (\$1.9M). A solid trotting filly, she has been 1-2-3 in 12 of 23 career starts. A consistent money maker, she has been racing against the best of the division all year, and with a bit of class relief, should continue to be a steady earner for her new connections in 2023. With her looks and pedigree, she is a natural broodmare prospect down the road being a daughter of CANTAB HALL, like the dams of ATLANTA (\$3.3M), MANCHEGO (\$3.1M), ARIANA G (\$2.4M), SOUTHWIND FRANK (\$1.9M), SIX PACK (\$1.9M), JUJUBEE (\$961K), NEXT LEVEL STUFF (\$836K), TEMPORAL HANOVER (\$835K), etc. A fantastic filly, she is racing at time of entry, so check for important updates.
