By WALNER, she is a half-sister to the Stakes Winner SAMO DIFFERENT DAY 2,1:54.2 (\$355K), and from the popular LINDILIANA family of horses like Hambletonian runner-up LINDY LANE 3,1:53 (\$895K) and World Champion EUROBOND 4,1:50.1 (\$530K). Lightly raced with only 15 career starts, she is just starting to regain her 2-year-old form, and is a great candidate to work her way up the conditioned ladder for her new connections, and would be a nice addition to a variety of racing stables.
