Ultra-consistent, he has hit the board in 9 of 10 seasonal starts, and trotted in 1:50.2, 1:51, 1:51, etc. As a 2YO, he sported a seasonal slate of 11-4-4-0, and won 2 legs and the \$250,000 final of the Kentucky Championship Series, taking his freshman record of 2,1:52.3.
