STATEMENT: This Stakes Winning 2-year-old colt by CAPTAINTEACHEROUS is a winner of over \$43,000 in 2024 at the time of entry. He paced to his lifetime record of p,2,1:53f-'24 winning a PASS at The Meadows and in his last start at time of entry, he just missed in the International Stallion at The Red Mile in p,1:50.1, pacing his last quarter in :26.2! In 7 pari-mutuel starts to date, he has been race-timed in sub-1:55 fashion in every one, including 1:52f at Pocono Downs, and shows last quarters as fast as :26 (finishing second to Captain Optimistic). By CAPTAINTEACHEROUS, sire of 2024's Metro S. Winner FALLOUT p,2,1:48.4-'24 (\$486K), he is a half-brother to the stakes placed LOU'S WORLD p,3,1:51-'24 (\$114K), and just the second foal from the Stakes Winner WORLD APART p,3,1:52.2f (\$328K). A top-bred prospect for 2025, this Pennsylvania-bred was a \$120,000 yearling purchase, and has already shown 1:50.1 speed despite being plagued by bad posts all year (only drawing inside post 6 twice in 7 starts). He will continue to race to the sale and should continue to improve for his new connections with time, maturity and additional racing experience. He remains eligible to this year's Kindergarten, Matron, and Governor's Cup Elim and Final. Eligible to be sustained to next years Bluegrass, Breeders Crown, Cane, Adios, Little Brown Jug, Meadowlands Pace, MGM Messenger Pace, PASS, Progress, Simcoe and Tattersalls Pace.
